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Opening Permission to Alphores High School Wardhannapet Mandal, Warangal District for Classes I to V (E.M) during the year 2020-2021 was accorded vide ref 4th cited.

The Mandal Educational Officer, Wardhannapet has recommended for Provisional Recognition for classes Pre-Primary to V (EM) to Alphores High School Wardhannapet Mandal, Warangal District through the letter 5th cited.

The application for Provisional Recognition has been verified with reference to the Inspection report of the Inspecting Officer and also with reference to the conditions laid down in permission orders and GO 1 cited and submitted a report in his/her letter 5th cited.

On examination of the proposals and recommendation of the Mandal Educational Officer, Wardhannapet and conditions prescribed in GO Ms No.01/Edn, dt.01-01-1994, the District Educational Officer, Warangal is hereby accord Provisional Recognition for the Classes Pre-Primary to V (E.M) in respect of Alphores High School Wardhannapet Mandal, Warangal District for a period of (10) Ten years commencing from the academic year i.e., from 2021-2022 to 2030-2031 subject to fulfillment of the conditions specified below:


1. That the Society shall abide by the instructions / rules regulations made by the Govt. or authorized office from time to time,
2. That the Educational Institutions shall serve the needs of the locality more particularly
3. That the Institutions shall adopt the curricular and syllabus prescribed from time to time.
4. The School timing vacation stand Midterms Holidays shall be as prescribed by the Govt. from time to time
5. That the verified staff within the age limits prescribed by the Govt. for Govt. Employees shall be appointed as per the Staff pattern.
6. That the results of Institutions shall be satisfactory every year.
7. That the records/accounts shall be furnished to the District Educational Officer every year by 30th September at the latest
8. That the list of Governing Body / Staff Selection Committee shall be furnished to the District Educational Officer every year.
9. That the pay structure / fee structure fixed by the Government body shall be got approved by the District Educational Officer, every year.
10. That the school shall not be closed without giving notice both to the parents and District Educational Officer at least (06) months before.
11. That the school shall be closed or permitted to be closed only from the date on which summer vacation is declared.
12. That the Society shall submit proposals of Provisional recognition sufficiently in advance i.e., at least (06) months prior to the date of expiry of the recognition.
13. Next higher classes/Additional Sections should not be opened without prior permission from the competent authority.
14. Sufficient play ground land for garden and library Books shall be provided as per rules.

15. That all the conditions prescribed in the G.O.s and other orders which are not specified in this order shall be complied with.
16. Provide suggestion boxes in prominent places in the school premises.
17. Compulsorily provide fire extinguishers and firefighting equipment as prescribed in the National Building Code of India part IV fire Protection 1997 and approved by Fire Service Department of the State. The management should submit the Fire NOC for their multistoried building within three months only as per the under taking given by the school Correspondent letter dated: 01.11.2014.
18. Maintain First Aid Kits in sufficient numbers in the school premises.
19. Follow the rules and regulation prescribed in Cir.Memo.21748/D1/97 Dt; 16-02 1998 and other orders of Transport, Authority regarding parking of school Vehicles from the Transport Authorities as prescribed by the Government from time to time.
20. The cost of providing Zebra Crossing at the Roads crossing near the schools, which are located in Municipal Corporation / Towns shall be met by the School Management.
21. Have adequate personnel to guide the movement of the children to ensure road safely and transportation.
22. The school management is the responsibility to get up to date periodical certificates from the concerned competent authorities for the interest of the teachers, parents & students.
23. Temporary recognition is granted subject to the verification of Vigilance and Higher Authorities if any defect is noticed by the authorities the Temporary recognition now granted will be withdrawn without prior notice to the Management.

The Management will be held responsible for any deviation in the following conditions in Opening of Pre-Primary section.

1. Pre-Primary Schools shall be established in well ventilated buildings only and they should be established preferably in ground floor only. The building be so located that should be away from the commercial establishments rush areas like markets, cinema halls, and also from natural barriers.
2. The play items provided shall be made non hazardous material and shall not have sharp edges and shall be age appropriate.
3. Sufficient No. of qualified teachers to teach the children shall be provided.
4. Safety measures:
 - a. Necessary infrastructure like class rooms, sanitation facilities, drinking water facilities, first aid etc., shall be provided.
 - b. The sufficient Number of trained Ayas and other supporting staff to be attached to the needy and safety of the children for each section.
 - c. Wherever the children are transported to school and from school to home, necessary parking, trained personnel shall be provided for guiding the children.

The Mandal Educational Officer, concerned (Inspection Officer) is requested to watch the above instructions at the time of visit/inspection and compliance of every month and report compliance. The receipt of these proceedings should be acknowledged.

Recognition was accorded for classes VI to X (E.M) for the academic year 2021-22, in respect of Alphores High School, Wardhannapet, Warangal Rural District., Wardhannapet(v), Wardhannapet(m), Warangal Rural(dist).

The Correspondent of Alphores High School, Wardhannapet, Warangal Rural District., Wardhannapet(v), Wardhannapet(m), Warangal Rural(dist) has submitted the proposals for grant of Renewal Recognition of classes VI to X (E.M) (with one section) from the year 2021-22 to 2030-31.

The Mandal Education Officer, Wardhannapet, Warangal Rural has verified the proposals with reference to the conditions laid down in the Recognition orders and GO Ms No 1/Edn, Dated: 01-01-1994 and subsequent Government Orders submitted a detailed report through the letter

After careful examination of the proposals of the Correspondent and report of the Mandal Education Officer, Wardhannapet, Warangal Rural based on the recommendation of the District Education Officer, Warangal Rural, the Regional Joint Director of School Education, Warangal is pleased to accord the Renewal Recognition of Classes VI to X (E.M) (with one section) for a period of ten (10) years from 2021-22 to 2030-31 in respect of Alphores High School, Wardhannapet, Warangal Rural District., Wardhannapet(v), Wardhannapet(m), Warangal Rural(dist). The management is requested to follow the conditions.

1. The above Renewal Recognition is accorded purely on a temporary basis and is subjected to the reports of State Level Inspection and Vigilance Committee fulfilling of all the pre requisite condition under the A.P Education Act 1982 and if later found that the school has not fulfilled any pre requisites as stipulated, the Renewal Recognition now being given is liable to be withdrawn at any time.

2. That the society shall abide to the rules and regulations made in the Govt. Orders 1st cited and subsequent orders.
3. That the Society shall provide the necessary amenities like accommodation sanitary facilities, drinking water facilities, furniture, Library, Laboratory, equipment play field required staff as per the staff pattern another facilities.
4. That the Renewal Recognition is accorded to the SHIVANI EDUCATIONAL SOCIETY.
5. The Renewal Recognition is accorded to run the school in the locality and there shall not be any change in the premises of locality specified in the orders.
6. The management should follow the G.O.Ms.No.22 ,dated 18-07-2017 i.e ., the weight of the school bag not to exceed 4kg for VI-VII,4.5 kg for VIII-IX and 5 kg for X.
7. That the administrative report and the audited statement of accounts of the school duly attested by the Chartered accountant for every financial year shall be submitted to the District Educational Officer, latest by September
8. The Management has to follow the government norms from time to time, for collection of fee from students.
9. That educational agency shall not use the premises building, play ground and vacant site belongs to the institution for any purpose other than the Educational activities and conducting authorized examinations without permission of DEO.
10. The management should follow the guidelines issued in G.O.Ms. No. 36., School Education (General) Dept., Dt:- 16-12-2017 for the safety and security of the children in the schools.
11. The management should pay the mandate taxes due to the concerned departments as per schedule fixed by the Government.
12. The school shall follow the traffic and safety guidelines indicated by the police and fire services departments
13. The school shall have 'first aid-kit' and the teachers shall be trained in first aid.
14. That any children studied in recognized school of other states/countries affiliated to the bodies recognized by the state or central government shall not be admitted without prior permission of the District Educational Officer/Director of School Education.
15. That the management shall not collect any fees or donations either in cash or kind other than the fees prescribed by the governing body from pupils or parents or any other person or on their behalf for any purpose.
16. That educational agency shall not force any member of the staff or students of the institutions to take part in the religious discourses and preaching of religion irrespective of whether they belong to the same belief or not.
17. If the Management provides transportation, it is the responsibility of the Management to submit Fitness Certificates of their buses every year regularly to the D.E.O. to have skilled, Trained, Licensed and healthy driver. If any deviation in this matter, they will be personally held responsible.
18. The Correspondent should submit Renewal of Recognition proposals before 90 days of the expiry of Renewal Recognition.

19. The Educational Agency should Implement the Guidelines for Safe and Effective use of Internet & Digital Technologies in schools and school buses issued by CBSE vide Circular No.Acad-32/2017, dated 18.08.2017 communicated by MHRD, Govt. of India.

20. The Educational Agency should Implement the Model Education Code prepared by National University for Educational Planning and Administration in 2015

21. That educational agency shall not permit the students of any D.Ed/B.Ed colleges or college of physical education or any teacher training institution to have teaching practice without the permission of the District Educational Officer.

22. Proper and adequate parking area for vehicles shall be provided transporting the children to and from the school.

23. Proper and adequate safety measures shall be taken for children within the school campus and also near the school premises.

24. The Parent Teachers Associations meeting shall be conducted to sensitize the parents on the safety of the children

25. The school shall constitute Committees for redressal of the Public/ Staff/ Parents/ Students grievances, Internal Complaints Committee on Sexual Harassment and Committees under POCSO (Protection of Children from Sexual Offence) Act, 2012 and details of these Committees along with contact details shall be displayed prominently on School Notice Board and conspicuously on the School Website for the information of all the stakeholders.
